AND WHEREAS the parties deemed it proper to reduce all the modified terms and conditions on which they shall be working in Partnership with effect from 1st day of April, 2004, in writing by means of this Deed of Partnership.

AND WHEREAS all the above mentioned parties desire the terms and conditions of the parties be reduced in writing in order to avoid any dispute or ambiguities in future.

NOW THEREFORE THIS DEED OF PARTNERSHIP WITNESSES, AS FOLLOWS :-

1. The name of the Partnership Firm shall be "D.K. ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTIONS".
2. That, the Partnership shall be deemed to have been commenced w.e.f. 1st day of April, 2004.
3. That, the office of this Partnership Firm will be situated At./P.O./P.S.: BELGAON, Dist.: BOLANGIR in the State of Orissa and the partners may mutually agree to change the same to any other place if they find it advantageous for the proper management of the Firm's business. The partners may by mutual consent open branch offices for the furtherance of the business of the Partnership Firm.

4. That, the business of the Partnership Firm shall be as contractor/ sub-contractor and carry on the business of executing Civil, Mechanical, and Electrical Engineering contracts fro State and Central Government Departments, local bodies, private parties, public sector undertaking etc., and to undertake fabrication and manufacture of equipment and other articles and for the purpose to run workshops and plants, to undertake transport contract and to do any other business or businesses as may be agreed upon by the partners from time-to-time.]

5. That, the Capital of the partnership business shall be contributed by the partners as per convenience and requirement of the business and further capital when needed shall be contributed by the partners as mutually agreed by them.

6. That, the initial capital contribution of the partnership firm shall as per their individual of each partner and the same may vary according to the needs of the firm in future and shall be contributed by the partners from their available means and resources. Simple interest shall be paid to partners at a rate fixed as per their mutual understanding and availability of profits of that relevant year. The partners shall be at liberty to increase or reduce the above rate of interest from time-to-time but it shall not exceed the rates as may be prescribed U/s 40(b)(iv) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any other applicable provision, as may be in force for the Income Tax assessment of the partnership firm for the relevant accounting period shall be payable by the partnership on the amount standing to the credit of the capital account of the partners. The net interest payable to all the partners in any year shall not exceed the amount of book profit for that year and no interest shall be payable to the partners in case of loss in any year. In case of net interest payable to all the partners being more than the book profit in any year, the same shall be limited to the amount of book profit and apportioned amongst the partners in the ratio of net simple interest of each partner. If there is any debit balance in the account of any partner, interest at the above rate shall be payable by him.

Book profit or loss for this purpose shall mean the profit or loss arrived at before charging the above interest on capital accounts of the partners and the salary payable to the partners.

7. That all the partners and have agreed to devote their time and engage them in conducting the business of partnership firm. In consideration thereof of the partner of the 1st part Sri. Dhirendra Kumar Jain shall be entitled to get a monthly

remuneration of Rs. 5000/- . and 2nd part Sri. Ganesh Chand Jain shall be entitled to a monthly remuneration of Rs. 5000/- and the same shall be credited to their respective capital accounts, further the remuneration and commission is restricted to :-

- A. In case of loss : Nil
- B. In case of profit not exceeding Rs. 50,000/- : 100% of profit
- C. In case of profit exceeding Rs. 50,000/- :
- a) Rs. 50,000/- or 90% of the first Rs. 75,000/- of the profit which ever is more;
 - b) 60% of next Rs. 75,000/- of profit; &
 - c) 40% of the balance amount of profit.

Profit or loss for this purpose shall be worked out after taking into account interest on capital contributed by the parties as stated in Clause (5) above.

It is hereby clarified that the total yearly remuneration and commission payable shall in no case exceed the maximum allowable amount prescribed by Section 40(b)(v) of the Income Tax Act, 1961. Partners at liberty to decide and distribute commission as per their mutual understanding between themselves.

8. That, the profits after salary, interest and commission shall be distributed as following ratio among the partner.

Partner of the 1 st Part	60%
Partner of the 2 nd Part	40%

9. That, the parties may by mutual consent make withdrawals from time-to-time for their personal needs and requirements which shall be treated as their drawings and be adjusted against the share of profit accruing to them at the end of each year.

10. That, the partners of the First and Second part shall be the managing partners of the firm, who may in his own name as principal, but in reality as agent of the other partners in relation to themselves enter into all business transaction as a partner of the firm.

11. That, banking account(s) of the firm shall be opened with any Bank/Banks and the all the Party are authorized to operate the Bank accounts in the name of the Firm, either jointly or severally depending upon the requirements and agreement with bankers.

The accounts shall be open to inspection to both the partners who shall also be entitled to take extracts and copies there from as they deem fit. Such accounts maintained in regular course shall be binding on both the parties unless any manifest error is pointed out in writing by the parties within reasonable time, in which case the same shall be rectified.

13. That, on 31st March of every year the P&L Account and the Balance Sheet shall be drawn up and the net profit and loss of the partnership as determined shall be duly adjusted among both the partners in the proportions as set-forth in Para 6 above.

14. That, the parties may for the purpose of smooth running of business raise loan or loans in the name of the firm from Bank, Financial Institutions, Corporation, Govt. or Semi Govt. departments or such private parties as may be thought proper and necessary from time-to-time.

The Partner of the *FIRST & SECOND PART* shall be liable to do all the acts for the firm and to appear before any authority or the Govt. or Semi Govt. Offices, Courts, Corporation, Banks, Statutory bodies, Organizations by what ever name called.

- (b) be just and faithful to each other and render true account and full information of all the things effecting the Partnership to one another.
